**Lawrence, KS**— In collaboration with KU's international area studies centers, the Spencer Museum of Art presents images of revolution in the 20<sup>th</sup> century in an installation titled *Changing the World: Images of Revolution*, on view February 12—March 1 in the Museum's third-floor Teaching Gallery.

These works, all drawn from the Spencer's renowned collection, depict political, social, and cultural revolutions in the 20<sup>th</sup> century, and appear in conjunction with the interdisciplinary KU topic entitled "Changing the World: The Meanings of Revolution." This theme is the subject of inquiry during the spring of 2009 for KU's international area studies centers: the Center for East Asian Studies; the Center of Latin American Studies; the Kansas African Studies Center; and the Center for Russian, East European and Eurasian Studies, as part of a year-long program devoted to "protest and revolution."

Related events include an artist's talk by noted Moscow conceptual artist Vitaly Komar on "Images of Revolution," February 26 at 5:30 PM in the SMA Auditorium; a forum entitled "What does "Revolution" Mean in Our Time? Society, the Environment, and the Arts," February 27 at 3 PM at The Commons in Spooner Hall; and a Teacher Workshop on "Art, Music and Revolution," February 28 at 8:30 AM in the SMA Galleries & Reception Room (enrollment required).
